The 9th, 11th and 13th notes are the same as the 2nd, 4th and 6th notes respectively, but:

A 9th chord is distinguished from a 2nd chord, for it includes a 7th or a b7.

An 11th chord is distinguished from a 4th chord (suspended), for it includes a 7th or a b7, as well as a 9th.

A 13th chord is distinguished from a 6th chord, for it includes a 7th or a b7, a 9th and in some cases an 11th (but not necessarily).

Extensions (9th, 11th, 13th)

In order for a 9th, 11th, or 13th chord to exist the seventh must be present in the chord. Otherwise, it's just a major chord with and added 2nd, 4th or 6th.

There are conditions when adding the 4 to a major chord. Usually the third is omitted, creating a new chord called a suspended chord. The abbreviation for this chord is "sus."




Olney Hymns; "1 Chronicles 17:16–17, Faith's Review and Expectation" John Newton (1725–1807), published in 1779, written 1772? It has been associated with more than 20 melodies, but in 1835 it was joined to a tune named "New Britain" (amalgamation of "Gallaher" and "St. Mary") to which it is most frequently sung today.

1835: William Walker, the composer who first joined John Newton's verses to "New Britain", to create the song that has become "Amazing Grace"

Another verse was first recorded in Harriet Beecher Stowe's immensely influential 1852 anti-slavery novel Uncle Tom's Cabin: He sings the sixth and fifth verses in that order, and Stowe included another verse not written by Newton that had been passed down orally in African American communities for at least 50 years. It was originally one of between 50 to 70 verses of a song titled "Jerusalem, My Happy Home" that first appeared in a 1790 book called A Collection of Sacred Ballads [U]


